The following are our current rates as of September 1st, 2017

- **Private Lessons:** Private lessons are being offered weekly, for 40 weeks from September 11th to June 22nd, 2017. Students may take 30, 45 or 60 minute sessions. Private sessions are offered year-round and join a session at any time, based on availability.

Cost of private lessons is as follows:

60 minute private: \$72.13/lesson + \$3.60 GST = \$75.73/lesson

45 minute private: \$63.19/lesson + \$3.15 = \$66.35/lesson

30 minute private: \$42.13/lesson + \$2.10 GST = \$44.24/lesson

- **Group Lessons:** The group sessions are offered primarily to students who have been riding previously in private sessions and require therapy in the area of socialization or are motivated by being with others. Not only will the students be motivated by the others in the lesson, but they will also be forming friendships through their common interest-horses! Group lessons are being offered weekly, for 40 weeks from September 11th to June 22nd, 2017. Students may take 30, 45 or 60 minute sessions. Private sessions are offered year-round and join a session at any time, based on availability. (Available to the general public, limited days only.)

Cost of Group lessons is as follows:

60 minute group: \$50.45 + \$2.52 GST/student = \$52.97/lesson

45 minute group: \$41.60 + \$2.08 GST/student = \$43.68/lesson

Equine Canada Rider Level Certification Program

All eligible riders (Erin will notify all those eligible) are now able to participate in the Equine Canada Rider Development program. Equine Canada fosters the standards for riders and coaches across Canada. This internationally recognized program is set up to accredit riders from beginner to advanced, giving riders important credentials for present and future pursuits. In addition to learning to ride, riders are taught horsemanship skills and theory. The riders involved in this program will attend their weekly or bi-weekly lesson and in addition will attend a Stable Management and theory class one Saturday afternoon/month. In June, riders who are prepared will have the opportunity to test their pre-determined rider level by an Equine Canada Examiner and receive a certificate for the rider level achieved. In addition to learning more about horse care and management and receiving credentials, participation in this program provides students with opportunities to learn good study habits and public speaking skills and assertiveness.

The following rates are costs involved with pursuing this program IN ADDITION to the weekly riding lesson costs:

Purchase of manuals: \$30 per manual + shipping and GST

Monthly Stable Management Class: \$20/month + GST/rider

Cost of testing: If riders are prepared to test the level in June 2018, there will be costs involved in the exam process itself to cover the cost of the examiner's time and the ordering of the official exam: \$155.00 + GST/rider, payable in May 2018. Riders who are not prepared to test in June do not have to pay this fee.

Annual Membership to the Saskatchewan Horse Federation: Riders involved in this program must be members of our Provincial Sports Organization. Not only does this membership assist the province in tracking individuals in their certification levels, but it also provides members with insurance during riding activities anywhere in the world.

Junior fees are: \$35/year

Adult fees are: \$50/year

Family fees are: \$120/year

First Time Students are not required to commit for the full 40 weeks. They can go through a trial period of 20 weeks from September 2017 to January 30th, 2018.

Returning students are required to register for the full 40 week period.
